PLAYER CONDUCT RULES AGREEMENT

- Players and Parents are responsible for their behavior and actions on and off the field at camp. We all want to have fun, develop in soccer, and be as successful as possible, but we must do so in a positive manner.
- Players are expected to follow all the rules and guidelines; proper behavior is mandatory.
- Players are expected and required to behave lawfully at all times. Unlawful or inappropriate behavior may result in immediate suspension or termination of participation in the program.
- Hazing and bullying are prohibited. Players must never behave in a violent or aggressive manner toward others. This includes the use of foul or abusive language, and physical contact with other campers. Players are not permitted to make remarks about race, religion, gender or ability. Players are not permitted to send harassing emails or text messages to other campers or post similar inappropriate comments about other campers on the Internet.
- Appropriate behavior in dining hall, other campus buildings and on field areas is expected.
- Damage to personal property and damage to any of the facilities of Delaware Valley University will not be tolerated.
- It is strongly recommended that campers do **NOT** bring cell phones to camp. Campers will be able to communicate with parents, however, we do not want cell phones used inappropriately for texting, downloading of materials, or using the camera options.
- Laptops and tablets are prohibited unless needed for summer classes and pre-approved by Camp Director.
- The use of cameras or video recording devices is not permitted at any time. Players may not circulate or post photos or videos of other campers on the Internet or any other means (i.e. APPS).

WAIVER

DISCLAIMER. None of National Futbol Academy Soccer Camps, Inc. collectively (NFASC) or such parties' respective officers, directors, trustees, employees, agents or representatives (including without limitation: coaches or Delaware Valley University, the "Released Parties"), are responsible for any loss of/ or damage to property, injury, or death suffered or incurred by any person while participating in, observing or otherwise being involved in any NFASC programs.

AUTHORIZATION. I verify that I am in good health and physical condition and able to participate in the NFASC programs. I agree that I will be bound by and comply with the rules, regulations and policies of NFASC, and to permit myself to be disciplined under those rules and policies in the event of noncompliance, as determined by NFASC, in its sole discretion.

I understand that participation in athletic activities, by its nature, involve a risk of serious injury. I acknowledge that I fully realize the dangers of participating in such activities, and fully assume all risks associated with my participation in such activities. To the extent that I am injured while attending the NFASC programs, I consent to being transported by NFASC, and its respective agents, employees, and representatives and/or emergency personnel for the purpose of obtaining medical treatment, and I further consent to any such care or treatment deemed necessary or appropriate by emergency medical personnel.

I, for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby waive, release, acquit and forever discharge the Released Parties from any and all claims, rights, demands, actions, liabilities, obligations, and causes of action of any and all kinds, major and character whatsoever, known or unknown ("Released Claims"), arising out of or relating to the NFASC programs and/or other activities, services and facilities provided by the Released Parties, it being expressly agreed and understood that I am giving the Released Parties a general release of any and all claims, present and future, that I may have against the Released Parties or any of them. I further agree that I will not sue the Released Parties with respect to the Released Claims. I understand that the granting of the foregoing release and covenant not to sue is an express condition to my being permitted to attend and participate in the NFASC program.

If a participant is a minor child, his/her parent or legal guardian must sign and/or otherwise acknowledge agreement to the above on such child's behalf.

PARENTS:

I agree that NFASC has the right to suspend or terminate my child's participation if my behavior or my child's behavior is deemed inappropriate.
